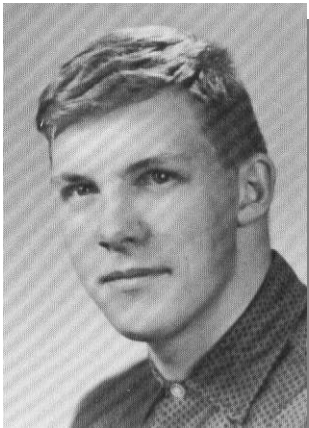

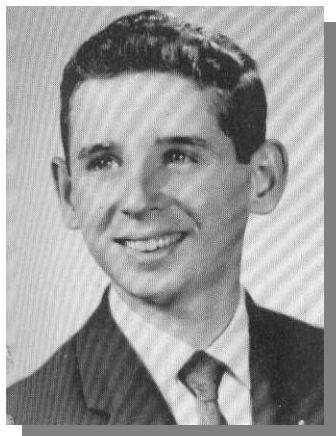

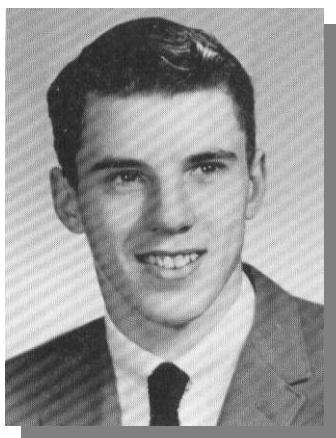

Peter Bruce Gilman (1944 - 2012)

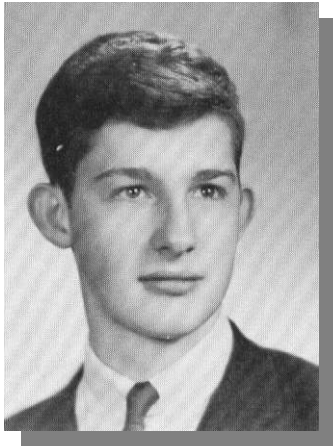

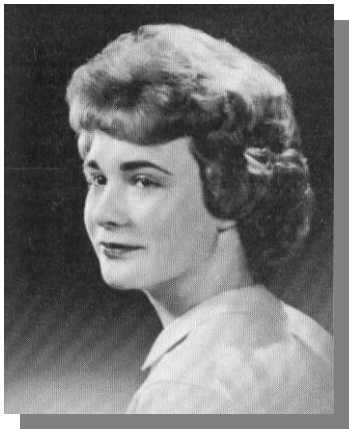

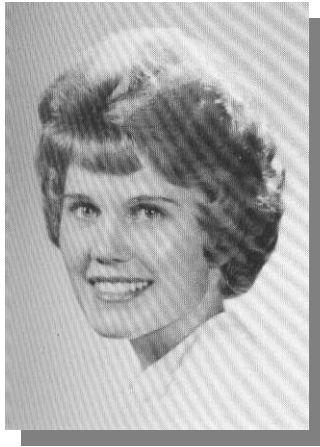
During my career as a nurse, I also worked as adjunct nursing faculty at NHTI in Concord. I went to UNH Graduate School and completed a M.S. in Nursing.

I have taken several community ed. classes. I developed an interest in genealogy and have been researching my family history.

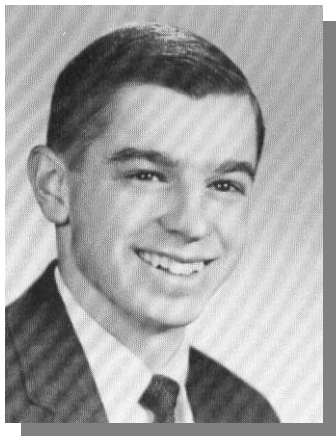
My husband has retired and is an avid golfer. We enjoy spending time with our family and friends. Have done some traveling and hope to do more.

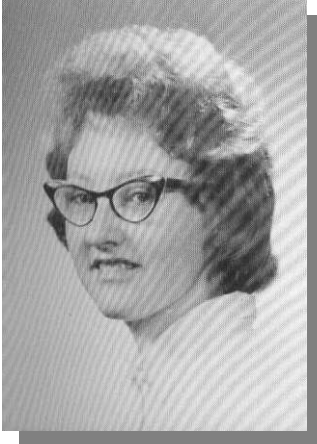

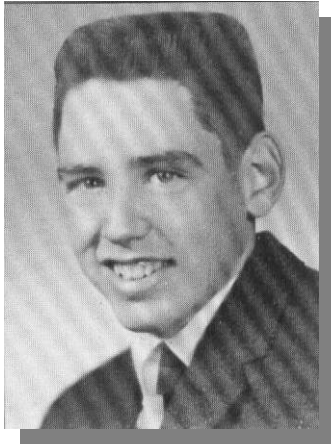

I am looking forward to seeing all of you at the reunion.

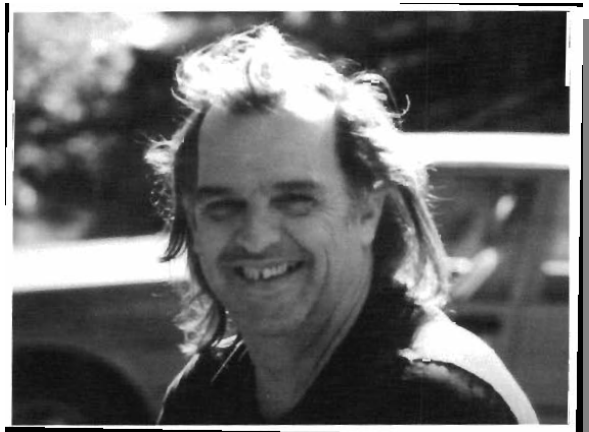
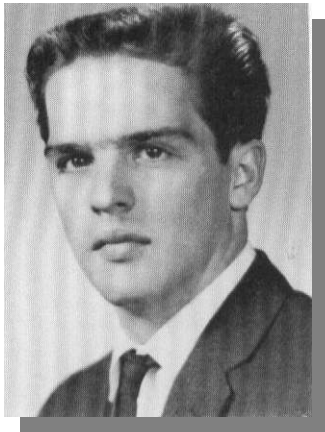
1992 COMMENTS:

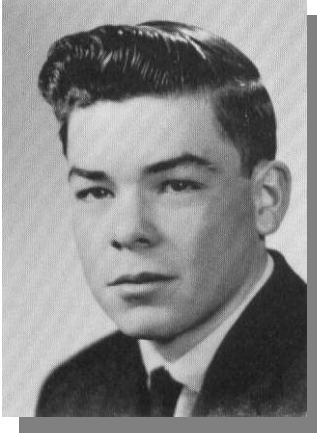
Obituary:

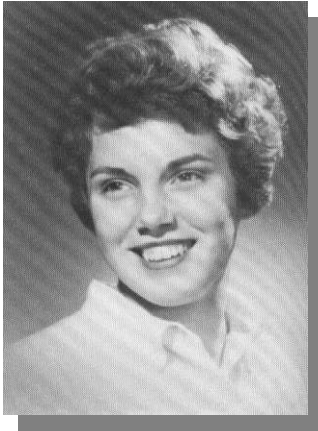
He leaves his wife of almost 44 years, 4 children and 10 grandchildren.

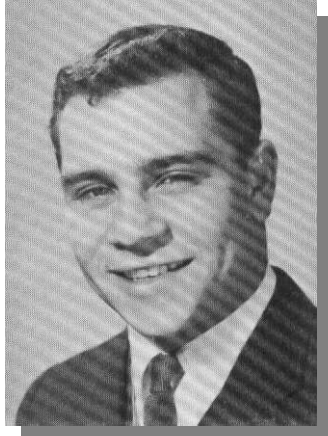
2012 COMMENTS:
