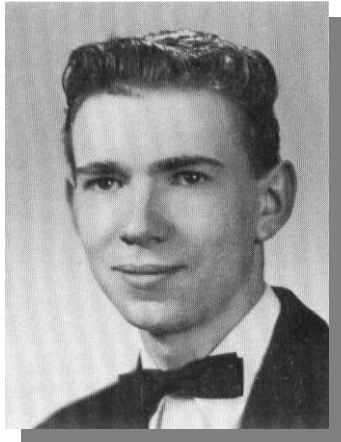

I have completed many Boston Marathons and still able to compete at this age in long-distance running.

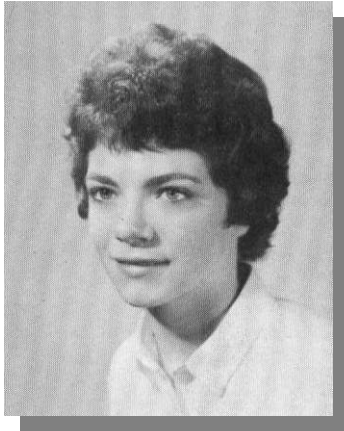
Being semi-retired allows me and my wife, Betsey, to spend more Time with our family.

I have been running over 10 years. I have been an avid runner and have completed 12 marathons including 7 Boston Marathons. In the last five years I have run over 10,000 miles.

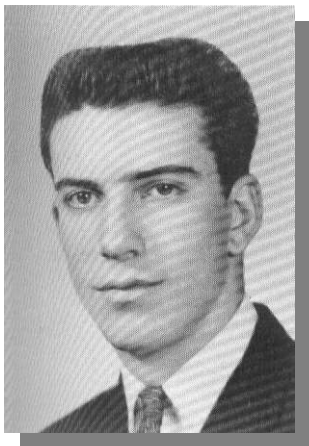
