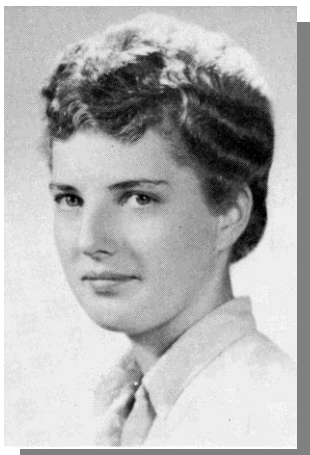

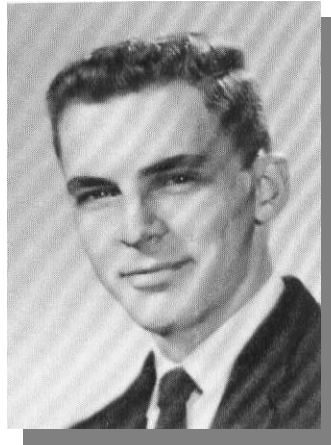

Got religion and married Claire Bergeron from Manchester, had 7 children with her, Anna, Simon, John, Maria, Michael, Benjamin and Rebecca.

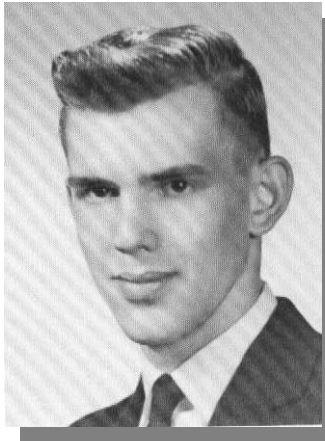
